**Ephesians 4:11-14** <sup>11</sup> And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, <sup>12</sup> to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, <sup>13</sup> until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, <sup>14</sup> so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. (ESV)

We are told that God has given us gifts to help us in times like these. We have people with the gifts of teaching the word and the message of Jesus (the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers).

We are given these gifts for a purpose. That purpose is the equip the church and to build up the church.
