To commune with (a person) as a fellow Christian 1

Ezra Taft Benson, a former United States Secretary of Agriculture said this about fellowship:

One very good way to experience rich fellowship in our church is by getting involved in a growth group. Here is the purpose of growth groups in our policy manual:

Growth groups are small groups of church members, attendees, and (occasionally) nonattendees who meet regularly in the homes of group members for the following purpose, to achieve spiritual growth in each member.³

Hebrews 10:24-25 ²⁴And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
